Torrent de Pareis

This adventurous gorge walk means meandering between gigantic boulders down the astonishingly deep canyon. The walk ends at the beautiful pebble beach of Sa Calobra.



Lluc Monastery

Easy round walk through forest valleys and Lluc's bizarre 'rock garden'.



Port de Soller to Deia

Coastal walk through two of Mallorca's most picturesque villages, along chalk cliffs and hidden bays, perfect for photographers.



Sa Trapa Monastery Ruins

A dramatic coastal walk with perfect views of Drangonera Island along cliff edges ending at the deserted monastery.



Galatzo

Beautiful and popular walk up one of Mallorca's highest peaks with panoramic views of the island at the top.



Around Orient

Charming walk along forest paths to a hidden cave and waterfall.

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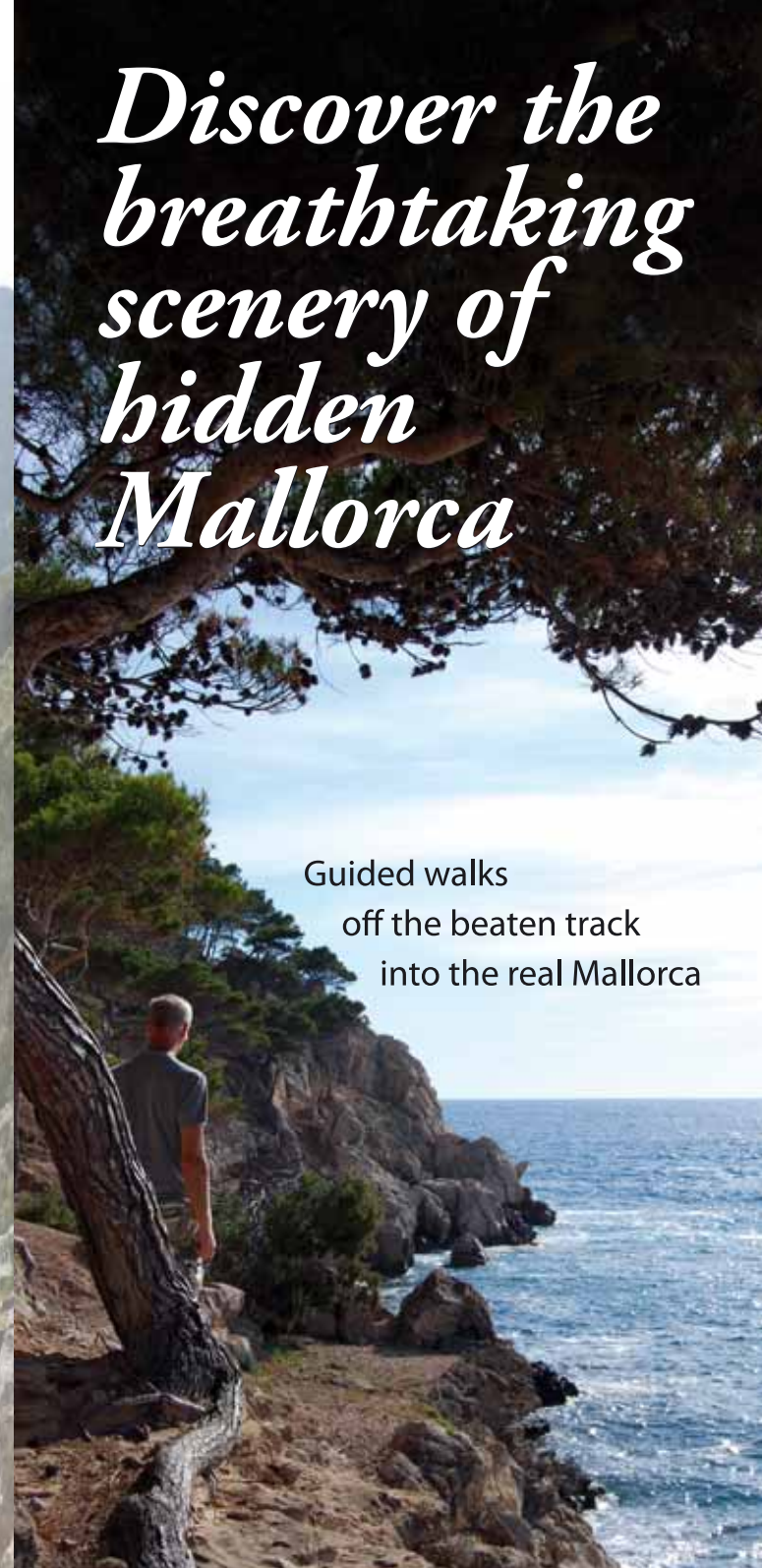
